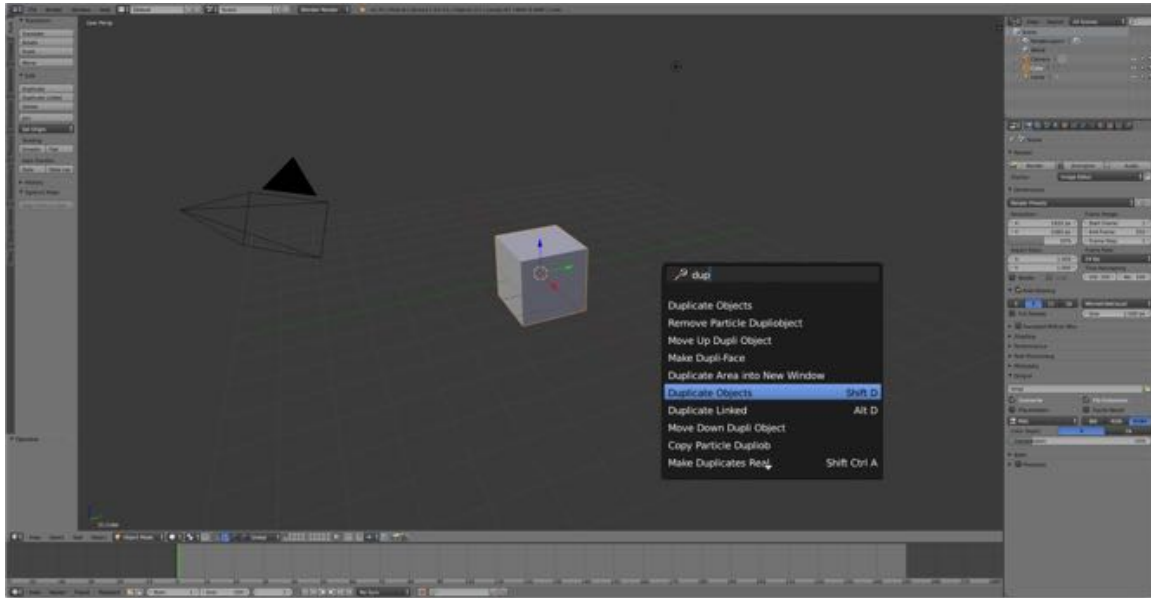
It's easy to search for a tool by name. Pressing the Spacebar brings up a menu with the cursor already positioned in the search box at the top. Simply begin typing in the tool name until it pops up below in the listing. LMB the listing activates the tool.

To Use the Tool:

- Press the **SPACEBAR** and **begin typing** the tool's name.

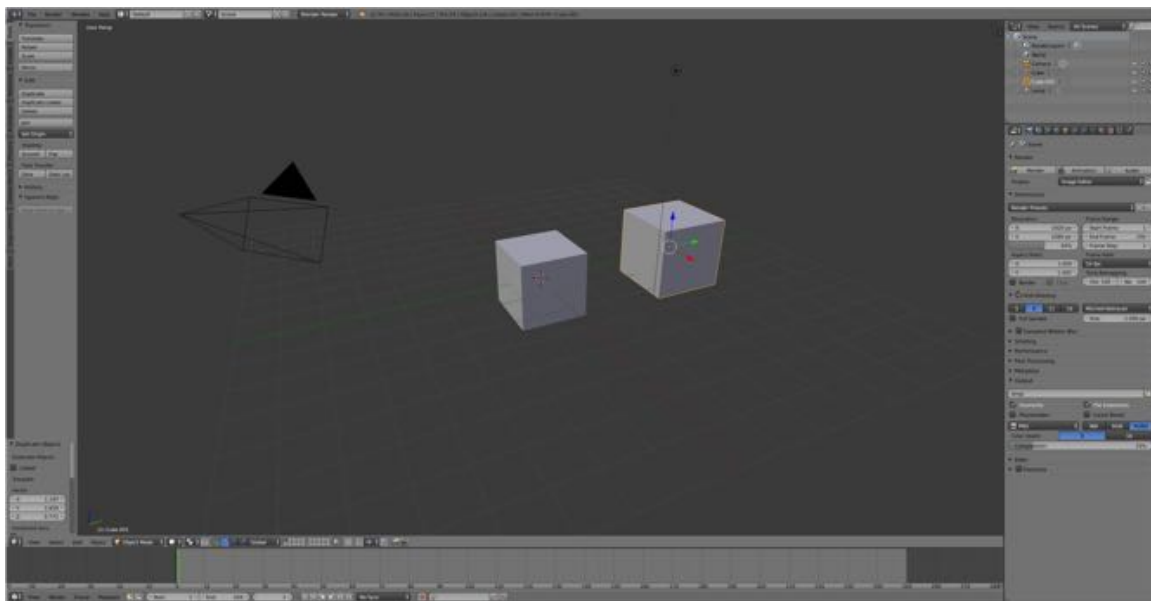
Let's Try It:

- **Open Blender.**
- Press the **SPACEBAR** and **begin typing** "duplicate" **dup...**
- **Select (LMB) Duplicate Objects (SHIFT + D-KEY)** and **drag** away from the original.

Additional Comments:

Blender also has a built in Dynamic Spacebar Menu Add-on. The menu list common tools and is context sensitive, e.g., for the 3D Editor's Object and Edit Modes.
