

Hide Splash Screen

Access:

Keyboard shortcut: None

Mode: All Modes

Panel: None

Menu: **Information Editor: Help > Splash Screen**

Description:

Going to the Help Menu of the Information Editor and selecting Splash Screen can always access the Splash Screen.

So it is convenient to hide the Splash Screen when Blender is opened and accessing it only when necessary. Opening the User Preference Window (CMD + PERIOD-KEY or Information Editor > File Menu > User Preferences) and under Interfaces LMB checking the Show Splash in the lower right-hand corner then LMB clicking Save User Settings will hide the Splash Screen until required. When the Splash Screen is accessed from the Help Menu, LMB clicking on previously saved files will close the currently open file and switch to the selected file.

To Use the Tool:

Hide Splash Screen

- Press **CMD + PERIOD-KEY** to access the User Preferences Window.
- Under the **Interface** Tab **LMB** check **Show Splash**.
- **LMB** **Save User Settings**.

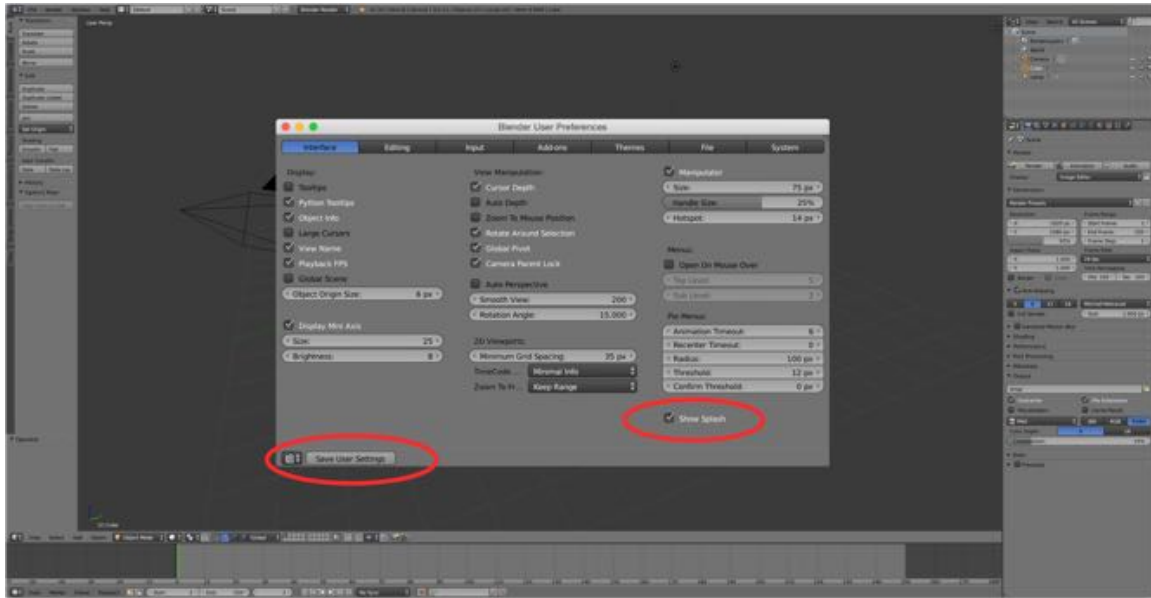
Access Splash Screen

- **LMB** on the Information Editor's Help Menu and select Splash Screen.

Let's Try It:

Hide Splash Screen

- **Open Blender**.
- Press **CMD + PERIOD-KEY** to access the User Preferences Window.
- Under the **Interface** Tab **LMB** check **Show Splash**.

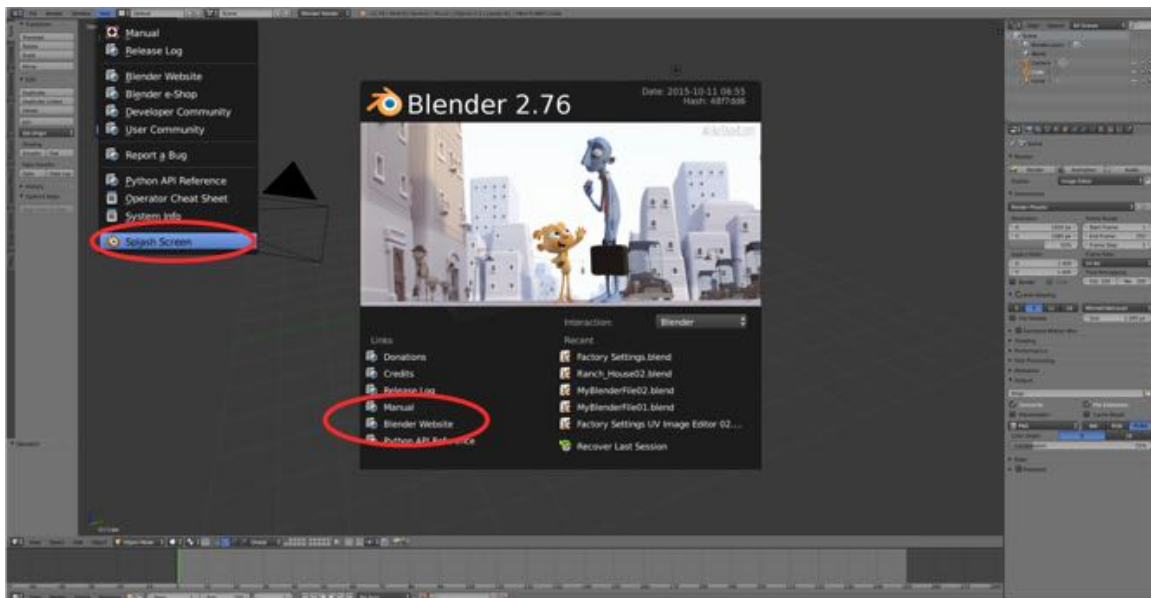

- LMB Save User Settings.
- Close the User Preferences Window.

- LMB on the Information Editor's Help Menu and select Splash Screen.
